Essay Questions and Answers

Q: What is the Optimist Essay Contest?

A: Every year, Optimist International sponsors an essay contest for the purpose of allowing students to express their perspective on worldly affairs. Local Optimist Clubs host the essay contest to further this initiative.

Q: Who is eligible to participate?

A: Any student 18 years or younger by October 1st, 2019 that has not been accepted to a degree-seeking program of a post-secondary institution can participate. There are no grade-level restrictions or minimum age requirements.
